Sacred Heart in Salisbury has cemetery plots available in their new church cemetery. Call the church office at 704-633-0591 for more information.

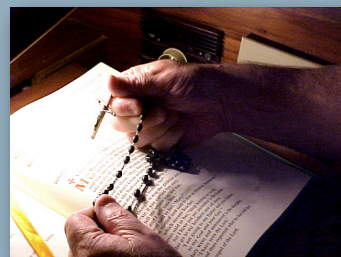
First Degree
