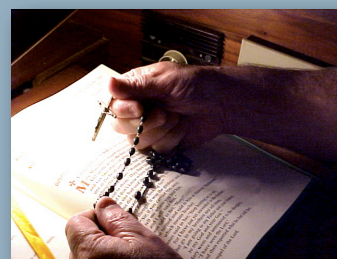

CONFLICT-OF-INTEREST POLICY

The officers and members of Knights of Columbus Central Piedmont Assembly Number 3158 in Concord, N.C. have adopted this Conflict-Of-Interest Policy.

The officers and members of the Central Piedmont Assembly 3158 shall avoid conflicts of interest and any conduct, which may suggest the appearance of impropriety in the day-to-day activities, grants, contract and awards of Assembly funds.

If a potential conflict of interest arises, the officer or member must disclose the potential conflict to the Faithful Navigator of the Assembly. Further, the officer or member shall not vote nor participate in the solicitation, negotiation, formation, award, arbitration, modification, or settlement of any grant, contract or award involving Assembly funds or any dispute arising under such grant, contract or award when the officer or member stands to benefit, either directly or indirectly from such grant, contract or award.

An officer or member of the Assembly is not deemed to benefit directly or indirectly from a grant, contract or award involving Assembly funds if he received only the salary or stipend due to him in the normal course of employment or service to the Central Piedmont Assembly 3158.

All officers and members of Assembly 3158 shall be informed of this policy.
